

Tuition Fees

At Tohoku Gakuin University, international students pay the same tuition as regular students. Details of tuition fees for each faculty and department can be found here.



Tuition Fee Reduction for International Students

Tohoku Gakuin University's tuition reduction program is intended for international students (regular students) who face difficulties continuing their studies due to financial reasons. New students must pay the full tuition fees at the time of enrollment. The reduced portion of the spring semester's tuition will be refunded later to the student's bank account. From the fall semester of the first year onward, payment slips will reflect the reduced tuition amount. We are currently reviewing a new tuition reduction system. Please note that students enrolling in April 2026 may be subject to a different reduction policy.



International students who hold a valid "Student" residence status and apply for tuition reduction at the beginning of the academic year.

Tuition Fee Reduction Period

The reduction is granted on a yearly basis and may be applied for during the standard duration of study. (4 years for undergraduate programs, 2 years for master's programs or the first phase of doctoral programs, and 3 years for the second phase of doctoral programs.)

Japanese Language Requirements

At Tohoku Gakuin University, most classes are conducted in Japanese. Therefore, applicants who wish to enroll must possess sufficient Japanese language proficiency to understand lectures.

Residency Status for International Students

The term 'international student' refers to refers to a foreign individual who enters Japan for the purpose of receiving education at a university or similar institution and subsequently enrolls in such an institution. Specifically, this applies to individuals who have entered Japan under the "Student" residency status as defined by the Immigration Control and Refugee Recognition Act, or those who entered under a different status and completed the necessary procedures to change their residency status to "Student" before admission.

Undergraduate Admissions Exam

Eligibility

Applicants must meet all the following conditions.

- (1) As of April 1, 2026, the applicant must be a foreign national and satisfy either of the following:
- (1) Have completed 12 years of formal education based on the standard curriculum in a foreign country or possess qualifications for university admission recognized in that country.
- ②Be approved by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology of Japan.
- (2) If residing in Japan, the applicant must change their residence status to "Student" before enrollment. If residing outside Japan, the applicant must obtain "Student" residence status upon enrollment.
- (3) The applicant must take the designated subjects in the Examination for Japanese University Admission for International Students (EJU) held in June or November 2025, and achieve scores equal to or higher than those listed in the table.

Required subjects vary depending on the faculty or department the applicant is applying to.

If the applicant fails to take all the subjects specified by the department, they will not be eligible to apply.
